



Rogue Retreat creates opportunities for people experiencing homelessness to have hope. We envision a community where all people experiencing homelessness have a place to call home and are empowered to strengthen the quality of their lives. Rogue Retreat meets people experiencing homelessness where they are (many with addiction and/or mental health challenges) and provides creative and temporary housing for them: a place to call home. With the help of community partners, we collectively wrap ourselves around program participants delivering supportive services to help them achieve their highest potential. Rogue Retreat provides housing and relationship-based case management that helps participants overcome the barriers that keep them from obtaining housing and becoming self-sufficient. For us, it's about community connection and restoring lives while creating and sharing stories of hope.

- **Rogue Retreat Crossings** (formerly known as Medford Urban Campground).  
Rogue Retreat Crossings consists of two phases.
  - In Phase 1, participants are provided tent sites and meals. The focus here is stabilizing people and providing them with a safe place that is staffed around the clock for their assistance and protection. Crossings is a low-barrier shelter site, meaning that there are no sobriety requirements for participants to receive services. However, those sheltered here are restricted from using drugs or alcohol on-site.
  - Once a participant is ready, they move on to Phase 2 with access to Pallet Shelters and Rigid Tents, which have electrical outlets, heating and cooling, and a locking door. There is a shower and laundry trailer to take care of personal hygiene needs. Case management participation is required. Participants in Phase 2 pay a monthly fee and are responsible for their own meals.
- **Kelly Shelter:** **You need to check in DAILY to stay on the active waitlist.**  
This is a co-ed dormitory-style shelter with a separate area for family rooms. Individuals, couples, and families are welcome. This is a low-barrier shelter site, meaning that there are no sobriety requirements for participants to receive services. However, those sheltered here are restricted from using drugs or alcohol on-site. Breakfast and Dinner are provided. Shelter guests are given up to seven days to determine if they would like to continue their shelter stay by becoming program participants and beginning case management services. Kelly Shelter participants may be allowed to stay up to 6-months, which may be extended by the shelter manager on a case-by-case basis with their case managers' recommendation or special circumstances.
- **Hope Village.** **You need to check in once a MONTH to stay on the active waitlist.**  
Hope Village is a safe, gated community of 38 tiny houses with shared living facilities. Shared facilities include a kitchen trailer, restroom and shower trailer, laundry room, community center, park area, dog park, and a vegetable garden. The village community members share in the care

of their community by doing daily chores and rotating gate watch duties. Participants are required to pay monthly program and utility fees and work with Rogue Retreat’s supportive services staff and community partners to address their individual barriers. This property is drug & alcohol-free housing as defined in ORS 90.243.

Applicants must be able to pass a pre-enrollment UA (including THC) and have 30 days clean from any drugs or alcohol if they are in recovery.

- **Housing Retreat. You need to check in once a MONTH to stay on the active waitlist.**

Housing Retreat units are 1 or 2-bedroom apartments owned by the Housing Authority of Jackson County and co-managed with Rogue Retreat. This is a rent-subsidized program for people who are currently and chronically homeless. Participants pay 30% of their adjusted gross income for rent and utilities. Must be able to pass the Housing Authority's criminal background check and meet homeless eligibility requirements. This property is drug & alcohol-free housing as defined in ORS 90.243. Applicants must be able to pass a pre-enrollment UA (including THC) and have 60 days clean from any drugs or alcohol if they are in recovery.

- **Restart Retreat. You need to check in once a MONTH to stay on the active waitlist.**

Restart Retreat units are 1 or 2-bedroom apartments that are an affordable housing second chance renters program for people experiencing homelessness who need a fresh start. Participants are responsible for paying full rent and utilities. This property is drug & alcohol-free housing as defined in ORS 90.243. Applicants must be able to pass a pre-enrollment UA (including THC) and have 60 days clean from any drugs or alcohol if they are in recovery.

**Eligibility:**

You must have at least 3 people in your household to be eligible for a 2-bedroom unit. All applicants must make less than 50% of the Median Family Income for their household size (see chart below, ask about family size over 5).
